

### The son who came home

It's about ten years now that our son is struggling spiritually. He went off the derech, left the house and caused us enormous pain. About nine months ago, I started listening to stories on the Tznius Hotline. I also took upon myself many commitments in Tznius, and I davened with tears that it should be a merit for my son to do Teshuva and come home. The same month that I connected to the Hotline, I started seeing changes. He started sharing with me what was going on with him, things that he had never shared before. The past few months my son faced many challenges, and we were able to help him pull through. He started coming home for Shabbos on a regular basis. However, it was on Rosh Hashanah night that the greatest miracle occurred. He sat and talked to us about his personal struggles. He told us that he started keeping Shabbos the past few weeks. He also said that he's planning on going to Shul on Rosh Hashana and Yom Kippur. I was shocked by what he said and I burst into tears. Then he appeared wearing Tzitzis. Again I cried and told him that I've been waiting for years to see him wearing tzitzis. It was obvious to me all throughout the challenging time, that Tznius is beloved to Hashem. Thereafter, I took upon myself to be part of the Tznius Hotline. I tried to connect as many women as possible, for the merit of my son. I believe that every commitment is very important in Hashem's eyes. I turn to mothers in similar situations and tell them "Don't give up, Hashem is waiting for us to strengthen ourselves in Tznius and then we will merit many salvations".

### A miracle – the unbelievable occurred

One of my children was having a very difficult time at school. He was struggling with ADHD, which also was compounded by behavioral problems. Unfortunately, the situation deteriorated and we were at a loss how to proceed. We got advice from experts in the field and consulted a competent Rav, who guided us throughout. We tried helping him in every way possible, but to no avail. In the end, after much deliberation and consultation, we decided to send him to dorm in a religious institution, to help him cope with all his issues. In the beginning, his situation improved immensely. But after a few months, his situation deteriorated drastically. He went from place to place and eventually ended up in a totally irreligious institution. He even went so far as to proclaim that he didn't believe in Hashem. We didn't give up. I managed to get 40 women together to connect to the Hotline and I davened that it should help my son. Then the unbelievable occurred!!! While in the confines of the irreligious institution, my son decided to do Teshuva. He threw out his smartphone and starting dressing like a yeshiva bochur. His irreligious friends ostracized him and told him he is a Charedi. He ignored them and started davening and keeping mitzvos. In the end, with tremendous siyata dishmaya, he was transferred to a religious institution. I turn to all women and say "The key to the yeshua is your hands, just open up your closet and remove all immodest clothing from your wardrobe." "You can save your family, don't delay." "Hashem sees your good intentions to strengthen yourselves in Tznius and will help you to fulfill them". I want to bless all women listening to the Hotline that Hashem

should help you to strengthen yourself in modesty, in speech, in thoughts and actions and you should merit many yeshuos!!!!
